HISTORY OF THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT

The Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Liberia which is presently housed in the Parker Building, Corner of Broad / Mechlin Streets was created by an Act of the National Legislature on August 25, 1987 during the administration of the Late President Samuel K. Doe.

This Ministry is the arm of government responsible for the formulation and implementation of policies, programs, regulations, guidelines and standards governing transportation in Liberia with the sole objective of providing an efficient, effective and affordable transportation service.

Prior to its creation into a full fledge Ministry under the Executive Branch of Government, the then Transportation Division was part of what was "Ministry of Commerce & Industry which was called Ministry of Commerce, Industry & Transportation". It has since been held by Cabinet Ministers in succession beginning with Honorable McCleod E.T. Darpoh.

VISION STATEMENT:

The vision of the Ministry of Transport is to achieve a coordinated, harmonized, affordable, effective and efficient transport system, consistent with international standards and responsive to the socio-economic growth and development of Liberia.

MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Ministry of Transport is to establish a policy framework that ensures an effective and efficient service delivery, and infrastructure development in support of the overall growth and development of Liberia which can be assured through the development and execution of the National Transport Policy and Strategy and the National Transport Master Plan.

In order to help achieve its vision, the Ministry of Transport has developed both a National Transport Policy and Strategy and National Transport Master Plan which were officially launched June 24, 2010 and May 29, 2012 respectively.

The current Minister of Transport is Honorable Madam Angela Cassell Bush who was appointed in July, 2014 by the President of the Republic of Liberia, Her Excellency Madam Ellen Johnson-Sirleaf as the 17th Minister.
